ADMISSIONS 2024-25

To meet the contemporary demands of many programmes, the University boasts state- of-the-art infrastructural facilities such as smart classrooms, virtual studio, data centre, well-equipped Research Laboratories and Lecture Theatres. The University has a fully automated library that is stocked with an adequate number of books (both physical and electronic), journals (both physical and online), and reference materials relating to the many disciplines/programs of study provided by the University.

General

Admission (for the session 2024-25 to all the Programmes of studies shall be made on the basis of merit through Common Entrance Test to be conducted at the University.

Completion of Admission Formalities

A candidate shall be considered as admitted to a Programme of Study and be eligible to be bonafide student of the University only after he/she has completed all the required formalities for admission including payment of the prescribed fees. If a candidate fails to complete the admission formalities by the prescribed date, he/she will automatically forfeit his/her right for admission.

List of selected candidates shall be displayed on the University Website. No intimation to the selected candidates will be sent by post.

The candidates shall be required to get their admissions completed by the dates as notified by the University from time to time and the candidates are advised to remain in touch with the .:

Official Website : Aryabhatta Knowledge University, Patna:. (akubihar.ac.in) for further updates. The selected candidates shall be required to produce, for verification at the time of reporting / last date prescribed for completion of the admission formalities, as the case may be the original documents thereof. In case of a candidate who is already in employment, No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the employer clearly mentioning that the employer has no objection in the candidate's selection/admission for pursuing higher education in there respective discipline/Programme of study in the Aryabhatta Knowledge University on regular basis. Such candidate (s) will be considered for admission only on production of a certificate from the employee that he/she has been granted leave for the prescribed duration in the University for more than one year, the candidate shall be required to submit an undertaking indicating the reasons for such gap and the activities in which he/she was engaged during the intervening period.

Only those candidates whose results of the qualifying examination is clear in all respects on the last date prescribed for admission in the University will be considered for admission to a Programme of Study. Each candidate admitted to a particular Programmes of study/discipline shall be required to submit his/her Migration Certificate in original within the prescribed time frame failing which his/her admission in the University shall stand cancelled. Degrees obtained through distance education mode and off- shore campus/study center will be valid only if they are issued in accordance with relevant regulations, guidelines and instructions issued by the Distance Education Council, UGC, AICTE&AIU.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

- i. The reservation of seats in each course shall be as per reservation rules of the Government of Bihar.
- ii. Reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PwD) will be followed as per orders of the Government of Bihar issued from time to time.
- iii. A maximum of two seats in each subject over and above the sanctioned seats shall be filled by applicants who have distinguished themselves in sports. Under this category, only those applicants shall be considered who have represented their University/State in different disciplines at state/national level events.
- iv. A maximum of two seats in each subject over and above the sanctioned seats shall be filled by applicants who have distinguished themselves in Fine Arts. Under this category, only those applicants shall be considered who have represented their University/State in different disciplines at state/national level events.
- v. Reservation for sons/daughters/ spouse of Military personnel/Defence Personnel will be followed as per provisions of the General Ordinance for Admission to Various Courses received from the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar. Patna vide its letter no. PU18/993944/GS(1) dated 28.8.1999. This reservation will also be over and above the normal sanctioned strength of the subject.
- vi. Reservation for sons/daughters of the respective university teachers will be followed as per provisions of the General Ordinance for Admission to Various Courses received from the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar, Patna vide its letter no. PU18/99-3944/GS(I) dated 28.8.1999. This reservation will also be over and above the normal sanctioned strength of the subject.
- vii. Reservation for sons/daughters of the respective university non-teaching staff will be followed as per provisions of the General Ordinance for Admission to Various Courses received from the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar, Patna vide its letter no. PU18/993944/GS(1) dated 28.8.1999. This reservation will also be over and above the normal sanctioned strength of the subject.
- viii. 2% seats of the sanctioned strength in any subjects may be filled with NRI/Foreign students. These seats will be treated as over and above the normal sanctioned strength. NRI candidates under this category shall submit their applications duly recommended by M.E.A. (Ministry of External Affairs) along with the copies of the documents showing NRI status.
- ix. A candidate seeking admission against under various reserved category i.e. SC/ST/EBC/OBC/WBC etc. has to mention about the category at the time of submitting the main admission application form and attach the supporting document to substantiate his/ her claim. Applications received separately later on shall be entertained.
- x. A candidate seeking admission against seats under special quota as mentioned above [7ii to 7.x] shall have to submit special quota application along with main admission application form and attach the supporting document to substantiate their claim. Applications received separately later on shall not be entertained.
- xi. No student shall be provided two weightages for the purpose of admission under special quota from 7.ii to 7.x.
- No applicant shall be admitted to the course who has not applied for admission within the notified time period.
- No such applicant shall be admitted who, in the opinion of the Head of the Department and endorsed by the Vice Chancellor, should not be admitted in the best interest of the University.
- During the tenure of the course, if it is found that any document/documents or submission made by a student in support of his/her admission to M.A./M.Sc. course is/are forged or fake, his/her admissions shall automatically stand cancelled. The concerned candidate shall be solely responsible

for the cancellation of his/her admission and other punitive action/actions.

- The Vice Chancellor of the respective University has the absolute right to reject /deny admission to any candidate without assigning any reason if he/she judges that this is in the best interest of the University.
- ☑ No candidate shall be allowed to register for any other degree course in the same University or any other university during the same academic session of his/her study of M.A. under the subjects of the Faculty of Humanities.

Admission Criteria

Ph.D/Master's Degree Programmes

Admission to all Programmes of studies shall be based on the merit of the students in Entrance Test. No candidate under these provisions shall be considered for admission unless he/she has appeared in the Entrance Test.
